Carolyn Joyce Patterson Wooton of Hico, Texas went home to be with her Lord and Savior on August 11, 2019 as she was surrounded by her family and others who loved her.

A private interment was held on August 14th at Morgan Mill Cemetery in Morgan Mill, Texas. She was laid to rest next to her late husband and high school sweetheart, Wayland Wooton. . Gary Wooton, of Morgan Mill, Texas officiated the meaningful service.

The eldest of three daughters, Carolyn was born to Hershel and Muriel Patterson on February 2, 1942 at the Stephenville Hospital. She attended Hico schools from first grade through graduation.
