



Dariece Warren Tinterow

December 14, 1932 - August 21, 2014

Born in Hico in 1932, the first child of Erma Lytle (Bobby) Poteet and Cecil O. Warren, Bobby Dariece Warren grew up on the family farm in Hico and later in Albuquerque with her younger brothers Bill and Gene. She married the violinist and band leader Bernard Bobby Tinterow of Galveston and Houston in 1955; they divorced in 1974. She raised her two sons, Chaya and Gary Tinterow, in Houston.

Dariece Tinterow was a painter and sculptor throughout her adult life and always delighted in portraying the people and pets close to her. A devoted and fun-loving wife and daughter-in-law, as well as mother to her sons and their friends, as she found time to make a career fundraising for medical charities, first as a volunteer and ultimately as chief development officer of the AMC Cancer Research Center in Denver, Colorado. After her retirement from AMC she co-founded the Free Clinic for Women Living and Coping with Breast Cancer in Houston, the focus of her energies until she was incapacitated by stroke eight years ago. Everyone who knew her recalls her beauty, grace, warmth, charm, and infinite enthusiasm for life.
