Dwayne owned and operated his own cattle, sheep, and farming operation named Lazy J Ranches throughout his entire life which inspired his two sons to create a major show cattle operation. He had served as President of the Chalk Mountain Cemetery Association, Sunday School Superintendent for Plainview Baptist

Church, President of the Erath County Independent Cattleman's Association, Member of the Central Texas Youth Fair, Member of the Somervell County Youth Fair, and Member of the Walnut Springs Business for Youth in Agriculture Support Group. Dwayne had a perfect Sunday School Attendance record throughout his entire life and would even attend church if no one could make it due to weather or illness just to make sure the doors had gotten open that day. He was the world champion at making a stubborn baby calf or lamb nurse its mother and an incredible 42 domino player. His granddaughters, Jaelynn and Adalynn were his whole world.
