Gay Lynn Bullard, age 64, died peacefully on the morning of April 12th 2021 at Baylor Scott and White Hospital in Temple after a courageous battle with brain trauma from a fall down a flight of stairs.

She moved to Hico with her parents and 2 sisters in the year of 1974, attended and graduated from Hico High School. Gay was preceded in death by her mother Delyghte Bullard, her grandparents as well as some well loved aunts, uncles and cousins. She is survived by her father Gaylon Bullard, sister Lisa Bullard, and her sister Jessie Uptergrove with spouse Wade. Gay is also survived by her nephew Justin with spouse Cassidy and child Hayden, her niece Ashley Stone with spouse Shawn and children Jaxon, Pason, Zoey and Tillson, and her niece Sara Roberts with spouse Chris and children Ella and Emmalyn.
