Jerry Lynn Magee, born February 3, 1937 in Dublin, Texas to parents Virgil and Flynych (Hanson) Magee, passed away on November 23, 2021 at age 84 in Hico, Texas. After graduating Hico High School in 1955, Jerry worked for over 38 years for Nabisco, which later became Kraft Foods, where he was a Teamster, Job Steward, and Trustee involved in critical labor contract negotiations in the 60's, 70's, and 80's. Jerry was a conservative Republican and member of the NRA, and an avid hunter and excellent shot. He also enjoyed working on cars and could fix anything.
