Ruby Coffelt passed away on Sunday, June 24, 2012, at age 94, in Meridian, Texas. She was born August 21, 1917 in Bosque County, Texas, the daughter of Rubin Sidney "Sid" McCoy and Julia Ardella "Della" Roden McCoy. Ruby was a granddaughter of David and Rachel Ann Elizabeth Ellison McCoy, and Jacob and Nancy Lackey Roden. Ruby's marriage to Charles Sidney Coffelt took place on December 29, 1934. Sidney Coffelt died in Temple, Texas, July 28, 1975.

During World War II, Ruby worked at Consolidated Vultee Aircraft Corporation in Fort Worth as a "Rosie the riveter", building B-24 bombers. After retiring to their stock farm near Walnut Springs in 1951, she became a licensed vocational nurse and worked in hospitals and clinics at Meridian, Glen Rose, and Clifton. During her later years she resided in Meridian, then in Meridian Manor.

She is survived by brothers: Bill McCoy and wife Marie, and Sid McCoy and wife Pamela, by nephews: Robert K. Coffelt and wife Sue, Rex Coffelt, Ronnie Locker, Dan McCoy, Justin McCoy, and Jeff Williams, and by nieces: Linda
